

VCF Solutions Catalog

The [VMware Cloud Foundation \(VCF\) Solutions Catalog](#) (formerly VMware Marketplace) would like to inform its users of an important change to Bitnami helm charts.

Bitnami has been publishing a large collection of Debian based container images and Helm charts for open source software on [Dockerhub](#). Bitnami also publishes Helm charts on the Solutions Catalog pointing to Dockerhub artifacts. Because of threats and attacks on the open source supply chain, Bitnami has decided to move away from Dockerhub and instead publish in a secure Broadcom repository. VCF customers will continue to have access to these artifacts and Bitnami will publish ongoing updates.

Users who have deployed Helm charts or containers from Bitnami's Dockerhub repo must update their charts with the new repo locations to avoid interruptions to their running applications. These Helm Chart changes will be published in the Solutions Catalog beginning on **August 28, 2025**.

The specific canonical change is as follows:

- Old endpoint: `docker.io/bitnami`
- New endpoint: `vcf.broadcom.com/oci-jx071ijn/sbitnami/containers/debian-12`

For example, Helm charts that point to

- **`docker.io/bitnami/apache:2.4.65-debian-12-r0`**

should now point to

- **`vcf.broadcom.com/oci-jx071ijn/sbitnami/containers/debian-12/apache:2.4.65-debian-12-r0`**

Bitnami will also be updating its charts in the Solutions Catalog. Bitnami will begin retiring the first images on DockerHub on **August 28, 2025**. To avoid any interruption, please update repo locations before then.

By implementing the above change, Solutions Catalog users can maintain access to the same software they were previously using. However, users can also consider upgrading to Bitnami Secure Images that are available in [Solutions Catalog](#) to gain a reduced attack surface, less CVEs, and compliance metadata such SBOMs, VEX, KEV and more.
